Dear School Family,

The mission statement of the Saint Titus Finance Council includes the following three goals:

1. Creating a secure financial foundation for our parish school
2. Keeping tuition affordable to our school families
3. Ensure that our parish staff receives a fair and sustainable level of compensation.

To help achieve these goals without undue increases in tuition, among other things we have reviewed the current practices of other parochial and private schools in our area.

Almost without exception, our neighboring schools require mandatory use of Sunday envelopes as well as purchases of both Scrip and participation in their parish fundraisers. Until last year, Saint Titus has required our school families to do no more than pay tuition. It is to the credit of so many of our schools families who have gone the extra mile generously and voluntarily supporting our parish fundraising efforts.

**For the 2009 school year the parish paid to the school a subsidy of \$1,200 for each single child, \$3,800 for each family with two children, and \$6,800 for each family with three children. This amount of subsidy is weakening the financial stability of the parish.**

Because of these rising costs, we can no longer depend solely on the voluntary efforts of school families. To keep our tuition affordable, we will again require each school family to purchase three Football Mania tickets per child for the 2010-2011 school year. The amount is folded into the tuition payments, so the cost will be spread throughout the year. If you choose to sell your tickets to family or friends, you can keep the added costs to zero. As with most parish fundraisers, these extra tickets sales will help the parish defray the costs of the subsidy it pays into the school helping to secure the financial stability of the parish.

The Financial Council and parish staff will continue to explore grants and other fundraising activities. We also strongly encourage each family to make full use of the Script and Market Day programs, both of which earn money for the parish and school to pay you credits which can be applied to your tuition bill!

We look forward to another successful school year here at Saint Titus!

## Discounts

A 5% discount is available on tuition paid in full by June 30<sup>th</sup>. However, \$500 per child will not be refundable should you choose not to send your child to Saint Titus. This is necessary to cover the costs of supplies and books purchased on behalf of your child/children.

Remember: If you refer a new family to Saint Titus and they register, you will receive \$100 credit towards your tuition.

## Refunds

The first month's tuition is non-refundable regardless of when the child leaves school. After the first month, tuition will be pro-rated as determined by the Pastor.
