Dear Parents/Guardians:

Once again this year, the Home & School Board has decided to celebrate our school children's birthdays by giving them a birthday certificate and a voucher for a free snack (\$.50) that can be redeemed at the school store during little recess. The students will get to keep the certificate, but will have to hand in the voucher at the time of redemption.

Since Pre-K does not buy any snacks, we will instead give them their birthday certificate with a special snack.

For children whose birthdays fall on the weekend, their birthday certificates will be included with the Friday birthdays. And for all those children whose birthday takes place during the summer months, we have assigned each child an "un-birthday." An "un-birthday," or half-birthday is usually the six month anniversary of the student's actual birthday. There will be two exceptions to this: for those children whose "un-birthday" takes place over the Christmas break, their "un-birthday" will be announced on the seven month anniversary of their actual birthday, and for those whose actual birthday takes place during the Christmas break, their birthday will be announced the week prior to Christmas break. Therefore, every student in the school will have their birthday announced.

Each morning after Mrs. Zinn announces the children's birthdays the birthday certificates and attached vouchers will be placed in each teacher's mailbox in the school office.

We ask that you, as the parent/guardian, make arrangements with your child's teacher if you would like to bring in a special treat for your child's class on their birthday/un-birthday.
