Key Points from the Implementation Guide for Catholic School Regionalization review:

- Updates on the meetings will be made available to parents promptly after each meeting.
- A Regional School name will be chosen from the List of names submitted by the school families. After prayerful consideration of the list, the Board of Governors will consider the best choice and submit it for approval to the Archdiocese.
- Create a picture of what the new Region School will be composed of as far as clubs, activities and programs: All three principals spoke of the existing programs at their schools. (see attached full list) It was suggested that we, at a later date, provide the list to parents and get feedback on programs and interest. This will take place after the School Name and Principal are chosen
- Prepare a Letter of Intent (to register at the new school) to be sent home to current parents/guardians for the 2012-2013 school year. This Letter will be sent out soon by the principals.
- Concerns on the logistics of the Open House were expressed.
 - As recommended by the Office for Catholic Education, it was determined the Open House will be on March 25, 2012 and the existing Implementation Committee will act as the host. They will guide families through the school and help them get a better sense of how the school will look in the fall.
- Discussed when to hold an Information Meeting for parents/guardians from all partnering schools. Determined date to be set after Principal has been named.
